

## **ONLINE-LEARNING DURING COVID-19**

In order to engage students meaningfully educators and parents need to find ways to deal with this unprecedented situation arising out of lockdown and undertake educational activities to support learning at home. To facilitate this process of learning, we will be organizing online / virtual classes for learners via using technology viz: zoom, MS Team/ what's app. These tools have the advantage of providing us with the facility to connect with more than one student and parent at a time.

There is a possibility that many of our learners may not have internet facility on their mobile or can use any of the social media tools. In such a situation, students may be guided through SMS or phone calls by the educators.

## **GUIDELINES FOR CONDUCTING ONLINE-LEARNING DURING COVID-19**

- 1. Teachers will be calling up parent's to inform about the process of online learning, at the same time school shall be sending message to parents regarding the same. There will be proper attendance for these classes, hence punctuality is essential.
- 2. Teachers will be creating the video link/ PPT/ or notes for the chapter explanation and share the same with the learner via what's app groups/ link on school portal, it will be followed by online session, where in Teachers will be explaining the chapter in detail and students can clarify their doubts.
- 3. In case, any learner is not able to access the link due to network issues and attend the class, teacher will coordinate with the learner and clarify his/her doubt via phone call.
- 4. Teachers to upload assignments and notes for the learner to understand the concept thoroughly.
- 5. Appropriate worksheets can also be created aligned with the activities along with those given in the textbooks.
- 6. Teachers can refer Chapter wise e-content available on the e-pathshala, NROER and DIKSHA portal of Government of India.
- 7. Educators on weekly basis to follow up & take necessary feedback with the parents and students over phone call.
- 8. Teachers may ask parents to observe changes in learner's behaviour and observe their learning pattern.
- 9. Periodic assessment will be an integrated part the teaching-learning process whether through face-to-face-mode or distance mode. Learners may be motivated for self-assessment.
- 10. Irregular students: proper follow-up to be taken by the class teacher and inform school management regarding the same.
- 11. Teachers will not force or suggest any material to be purchased from outside.

## **Learner's with limited access to internet**

- 1. If incase, any learner is not able to attend the class or contact teacher for clarifying doubts, they can take the hard copy of the study material from school with prior information.
- 2. Educators can suggest and inform them about various education channels and programmes available on TV and radio.

## **GUIDELINES FOR ONLINE LEARNING MODULE**

Covid-19 has created a new challenge and environment not only for learners but educators too.

Educators to ensure topics are selected from the syllabus and are linked with the learning outcome, ensuring continuous learning for the learners. But it is a matter of fact that many teachers and parents only have simple mobile phones as a tool available at their homes and all the teachers and students do not have virtual classroom facility. In view of this the activities are designed and presented in such a way that many activities can be conducted by the parents and students on their own after talking to the teachers over phone. The teachers can contact parents and student's simple mobile phones to internet based diverse technological tools for giving them the appropriate guidelines for conducting these activities.

- 2. Lesson plan should be developed keeping in mind available resources at home and in an eco-friendly manner, without any financial burden on parents or guardians
- 3. Lesson plans should be implemented through innovative and joyful experiential pedagogies such as Art-Integrated and Sport-Integrated Learning, Storytelling, etc. which promote reflection, critical thinking, creativity, initiation, self-direction and other 21st Century Skills.
