In which 07 students MAYANK KUMAR 98.6%, RAJDEEP SINGH 98%, VIKAS YADAV 97.4%, CHETAN SHARMA 96.4%, VAIBHAV SINGH 96.2%, ADITYA UNIYAL 96%, KESHAV KAUSHIK 96% have scored above 95%.

Working closely with schools in USA, Morroco, Pakistan, Srilanka , UK, Egypt and other countries around the world via various projects, Skype sessions, e-mail and other means of communication.
