





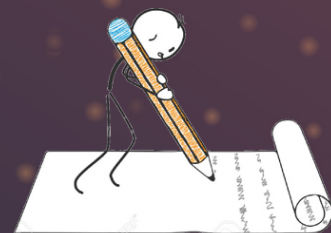

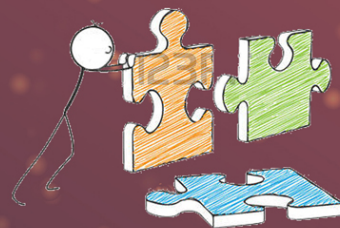

GST (Goods and service Tax)

GST is a tax levied when a consumer buys a good or service. The current tax regime is riddled with indirect taxes which the GST aims to subsume with a single comprehensive tax, bringing it all under a single umbrella. It means, various Taxes like waiting duty, octroi, luxury Tax and entry tax will be included under a single roof by GST. The very important feature of GST bill is that instead of collection of taxes at every step, it will be collected in one step. Goods and services will be treated equally and will be taxed similarly.

Subsume all indirect taxes at the centre and the state level one country one tax rescue the cascading effect of taxes increase productivity and transparency increase tax- GDP ratio Reduce/ Eliminate tax evasion and corruption

Alcoholic liquor for human consumption is exempt from GST.

Initially, GST will not apply to:

- Petroleum crude
- High speed diesel
- Motor spirit
- Natural gas (CNG)
- Aviation turbine fuel.

In modern times, state participation in various activities can hardly be a matter of the disagreement. The free play of economic forces, even in highly developed capitalist countries has often meant large unemployment and instability of the economics system. In the advanced countries the instruction has been invoked to ensure economics stability and full employment of resources. State action is all the more inevitable in under developed economies which are struggling hard to get rid of poverty and to attain higher living standard.

Accordingly, governments are playing a vital role in the development of underdeveloped economies. Their role is all more remarkable in the various respects such as comprehensive planning, institution of controls, social and economics overheads, institutional and organizational reforms, setting up financial institution, public undertakings, and economics planning. In the initial phase the process of development in an under developed country is held up primarily by the lack of basic social and economic overheads such as schools, technical institution and research institutes hospitals and railways, roads, ports, harbors and bridges etc. To provide them requires very large investments.

Such investments will lead to the creation of external economies which in their turn will provide incentives to the development of private enterprise in the field of industry as well as of agriculture. The governments therefore, go all out in building up the infrastructure of the economy for initiating the process of economic growth.

Private enterprise will not undertake investments in social overheads. The reason is that the returns from them in the form of an increase in the supply of technical skills and higher standards of education and health can be realized only over a long period besides, these return will accrue to the whole society rather than to those entrepreneurs who incur the necessary large expenditure on the creation of such costly social overheads.

ROAD SAFETY: A NATIONAL CONCERN

Safety is everyone's prime concern. But how some people neglect it every day. Newspapers are splashed with many accounts of road accidents. Young kids are regularly being killed by buses or trucks because of narrow encroached roads as well as violation of rules of the road.

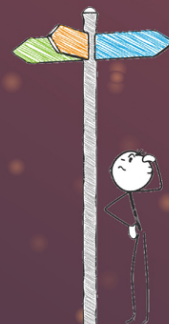
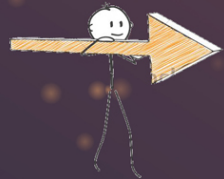
THE INNER BEAUTY

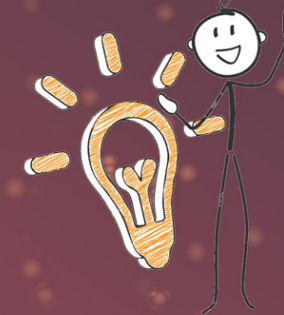
